High-Velocity Learning

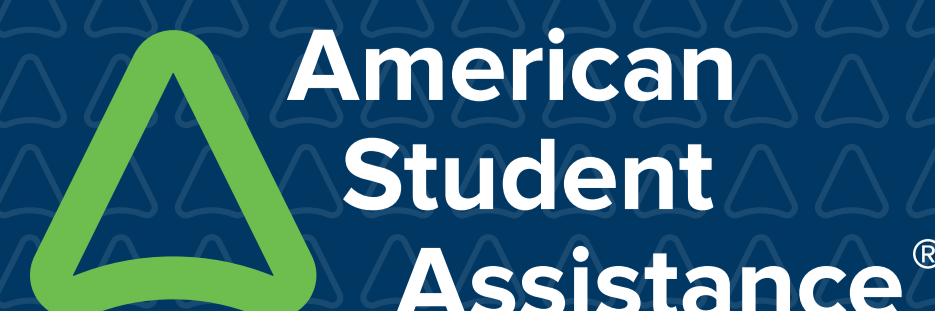
Hands-on problem solving in real-life simulations puts students in the role of active learner rather than passive recipient.
