

## **State Highlight**

**Building capacity of middle school educators.** The Mississippi State Board of Education's <u>strategic plan</u> outlines a strategy to target professional learning for teachers and leaders in the middle grades to develop the whole child; this includes mentoring students as they explore authentic pathways.



**State Definition.** Mississippi <u>defines</u> career exploration as "essentially finding out about different occupations and their 'fit' with your interest level in various careers."

Mississippi has yet to codify its definition of career exploration and state career exploration as an official priority.



Student Success Plan. All 7th grade students are required to develop an Individual Success Plan (ISP). Mississippi Career Exploration and Planning Expectations specify that each student should have an ISP to help them make career and college decisions, plan a course of study, and make financial aid assessments with family members. These expectations outline what each student in grades 6-8 should know and do to achieve this goal.

Mississippi has yet to formally include middle school career exploration in state and federal accountability systems.



Career Exploration Lesson Plans. The Mississippi Department of Education provides grade-specific lesson plans to help schools and teachers with K-12 career exploration programs.

Mississippi has yet to provide dynamic training opportunities to staff related to middle school career exploration and resources that emphasize best practice.

Advocacy Are there organizations within the state that are advocating for middle school career exploration?	Building Emerging Advanced	MS does not have any organizations advocating for middle school career exploration that rose to recognition within the landscape scan.

Accountability  Does the state integrate career exploration into their accountability systems?	Building Emergi	ng Advanced	The state does not integrate career exploration into its ESSA state plan. However, MS includes middle school career exploratory programs in their <u>Perkins V Plan</u> .
Student Requirements  Does the state have policies that require middle school students to complete career exploration activities?	Building Emergi	ng Advanced	Beginning in school year 2018-2019, all 7th grade students are <u>required</u> to have an Individual Success Plan (ISP) prior to exiting grade 7.
Incentives  Does the state have policies that incentivize career exploration in middle schools?	Building Emergi	ng Advanced	MS does not have any incentives directly related to middle school career exploration.

Funding  Does the state use state or federal funding sources to support career exploration for middle school students?	Building Emerging Advanced	MS uses <u>ESSA funds</u> to support the individual student success plan process and college and career counseling. State <u>Perkins V dollars</u> support developing new curriculum for middle school exploratory programs.
Professional Development  Does the state support the training of school counselors (and other school staff) in career exploration?	Building Emerging Advanced	The State Board of Education's <u>strategic plan</u> outlines a requirement to incorporate career pathway professional development for teachers who teach middle grades to build their capacity to develop the whole child, including mentoring students as they explore career pathways.
Material Supports  Does the state provide material supports on the implementation of middle school career exploration?	Building Emerging Advanced	The Department of Education provides <u>grade-specific lesson plans</u> to help schools establish a K-12 career exploration program.
Data Collection  Does the state collect data on middle school career exploration opportunities in the state?	Building Emerging Advanced	There are no formal state-level data collection practices related to middle school career exploration.
CTSOs  Does the state support participation in career and technical student organizations?	Building Emerging Advanced	MS has <u>middle school chapters</u> in HOSA and TSA.
Organizations  Are there organizations within the state that support career exploration in middle schools?	Building Emerging Advanced	Get2College is a college access program of the Woodward Hines Education Foundation. They have a career planning tool available to students and educators.  Mississippi State University received a grant from the Appalachian Regional Commission Partnerships for Opportunity and Workforce and Economic Revitalization Initiative to provide VR headsets and education software to prepare students for the workforce.
